Analysis of Students Satisfactory - Survey session 2020-21

Meeting of Grievance and Redressal Cell was held on 30.11.20 in the office of the Principal. In this meeting analysis of student satisfactory - survey was done. It was observed that total 283 students responses were received and tabulated. The committee analysed the received online performas and the following data was obtained.

1. It was observed that 78% attended their classes regularly, 11% frequently and 11% sometimes through online and offline mode.
2. Students could not attend their classes due to lack of internet facilities, availability of single phone, many health issues like covid-19, pregnancy, delivery and household work.
3. 90% students found their classes' interesting and 83% students responded that they were provided study material by their teachers.
4. 96% students agreed that teachers were helpful and 94% students approached their teachers for guidance and support.
5. Majority of students responded that college infrastructure was good. 70% students were satisfied with college administrative support and 80% students were satisfied with the library staff.
6. It was observed that 30% students participated in sports.
7. 64% students in cultural activities, 9% students in N.C.C and 18% in N.S.S.
8. It was observed that 93% students were timely informed about various official notices.
9. 93% students responded that extension lectures/ seminars were organized regularly in college.
10. 73% students were aware of complaint - boxes and suggestion boxes kept in college and 70% students got redressal for their complaints personally.
11. 96% students found college campus was safe and 89% students responded that college campus was ragging free.




